

Coweta Public Schools are in search of children with disabilities in the Coweta School district that may indicate a need for special learning facilities or programs.

Federal and state law requires a free and appropriate education for all individuals with disabilities through the age of 21.

Characteristics that may affect your child's educational progress and may qualify your child for a special evaluation are visual impairments, mental disabilities, learning disabilities, hearing or speech problems, severe emotional disturbance, physical limitations, multiple disabilities, health impairments, and traumatic brain injury.
