

Coweta Public Schools will provide a FREE Breakfast and Lunch to all children 18 years old and under during the 2021-22 School Year.

In an effort to help families and students during the ongoing COVID-19 pandemic, USDA is making school meals FREE to any child 18 years old and under.

Distance Learning or Virtual students will need to call (918) 486-0802 by 9:00 am the day of to request their meals. You will need to provide the name of the child receiving the meals.

Meals will be available for pick up at the Main Kitchen (407 N. Broadway) between 11:00 am – 12:00 pm. Monday – Friday on the day's school is in session.

In-person students will still use their school ID number as they go through the cafeteria lines, but will not be charged. If your child's school sells a la carte items, they will still be available but the student must have money in hand or on their account to purchase these items.

Although meals are free, parents are strongly encouraged to complete a Free or Reduced Meal Application. These applications are critical in helping CPS receive additional school funding.
