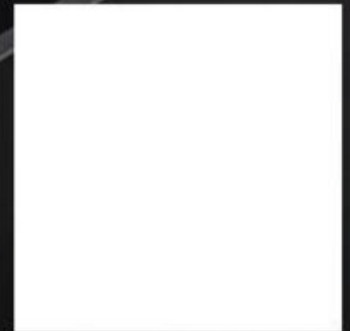

Black Card

Requirements:

- Students must pass all state mandated tests
- Students must attempt the ACT test
- Students that do not pass all state mandated tests may be eligible for Black Card after the first semester of their Senior year by meeting the following criteria:
 - Maintaining Academic Eligibility for the 1st Semester
 - Final first semester grades must be a “C” or higher
 - No suspensions or IP Placements

Privileges:

- *Off Campus Lunch on dates specified by the administration*
- *Free Admission to all CHS Athletic Events and Activities*
- *Exemption from all Senior Finals*
- *Unlimited Hall Passes – upon teacher approval*
- *2 free “daily assignment” Homework Passes*
- *1 Free Tardy per class per semester*

Exemptions

You are exempt from semester tests if:

- Black Card Member OR
- Carry an “A” or “B” average in all classes
- Have no more than 5 absences in any one class for any reason
- 4 tardies = 1 absence
- NO IP or Suspensions

Absences

Parent/Guardian must contact the school at 918-486-4474 any time you are absent.

Students who exceed 10 absences in a given semester will receive a grade of F(maximum of 59%) prior to the semester exam. The final grade will be calculated as an average of 59% of the total possible for the semester and the grade earned on the semester exam.

All absences with the exception of a school activity and college visit will count against this total.

Bring your doctor/dentists notes to the high school office and give to Ms. Cooper

College visits are 2 per school year (Juniors and Seniors)

Tardies

- All students who have 1st hour in the main building will report to the office if they arrive after the tardy bell has sounded.

1st Tardy - Verbal warning

2nd Tardy - Parent contacted and student issued 1 lunch detention.

3rd Tardy - Parent contacted and student issued 2 lunch detentions.

4th Tardy - Parent contacted and student issued 3 lunch detentions.

5th Tardy - Referral to the Assistant Principal.

Be On Time To School

TOBACCO/DRUGS/ALCOHOL

- Possession/use will result in suspension.
- All prescription medication must be checked in thru the main office
- Tylenol/Advil will not dispersed in office- you must bring your own and check it in
- NO EXCEPTIONS! Failure to comply with this policy will result in suspension

SEARCH AND SEIZURE

- Pursuant to OK State Tit. 24 S 102 (1991) This law authorizes the school principal or his/her designee to detain and search any student and property in the student's possession and require a specimen for urinalysis upon reasonable suspicion that a violation of the law or school rules has occurred or is occurring.
- You bring it, we can search it... including cars

DRESS CODE INFO

No long or large coats or sunglasses will be worn in building.

No blankets or house shoes!!!!

Hats are allowed in Commons and Hallway- Teacher discretion in classrooms

VIOLATORS OF THE DRESS CODE

- THOSE SENT TO THE OFFICE WILL BE REQUIRED TO CHANGE TO SCHOOL APPROPRIATE ATTIRE
- THE SCHOOL WILL PROVIDE SCHOOL APPROPRIATE CLOTHING FOR THE REMAINDER OF THE DAY (SWEATS/ T-SHIRT) IF THE STUDENT CANNOT PROVIDE THEIR OWN

NO CELL PHONES WHILE DRIVING

- No Cell Phone usage in school zone
- Coweta PD will be issuing tickets

PARKING

- Students must park their automobile in a *student designated* parking space – **inside** the lines. Students must have a parking permit issued from the school visible inside their vehicles
No Parking Permit=Saturday School
- Students may not park on the curb in front of the main entrance, **this is a fire lane**

PARKING

- Students must exit their vehicles when they arrive, they are not allowed to go to their vehicle during the school day unless they are accompanied by the Administration.
- No bus riders in the parking lot
- No sitting in your car, on your car or by your car
- Parking lot should be empty by 3:15!!!!!!!!!!!!!!!!!!!!!!!!!!!!

PARKING

- No parking in Staff Spots at the HS or IHigh
- Loitering is not permitted in the parking lot

Failure to comply with Student Vehicle rules could result in suspension

Cafeteria

- Keep it clean! Pick up your trash!
- Parents must be present IN PERSON to check you out for lunch

- Commons area
- Library (must have a library pass and these are first come first serve.)

NOT in

HALLWAYS/GYM!!!!!!

Cafeteria

- Visitors are not allowed to eat lunch with you unless they have permission from Mr. Ellis or Ms. Bible

IN ADVANCE

Conduct in Hall

- Stay out of Halls during lunch and class time
- Must have a pass
- Will not be allowed in Halls before 8:15 without a Pass
- *Be on time for your class, you're a distraction when you enter late*
- Food and Drink is up to your classroom teacher

- Will have the opportunity to apply to be in NHS their 2nd semester at CHS. They currently aren't members until they are inducted.
