## **Free and Reduced Lunches**

Your child may qualify for free or reduced lunches. This lunch program assists our students but also qualifies our school for additional funding, so your participation is important to us. Since a large majority of our applicants will be approved through Direct Certification, this should allow approvals in a timely manner. Letters will be sent to all families as soon as they are approved. Any families that do not carry over will be sent an application. The cashiers in each lunch room will be handling the forms this year, so if you need to fill out an application or check your status, contact the school. If you have other questions please contact Vicki Middleton, Director of Child Nutrition, at 918-279-1581. **The lunch prices are \$2.75 for students and \$3.75 for adults. Student Breakfast cost \$1.85 and adult breakfast is \$2.10.**

Students may bring their lunch or eat a cafeteria lunch each day. A menu will be sent home with your child and we will announce to the students if there is a change. All meals follow the federal regulations and include fruit and vegetables with the entree.
